10. <u>Special Reports</u> – Mr. Hall, Mrs. Lucas, Mr. Schmidt, and Mrs. Goodge gave an update on the Auburn Academy and Personalized Learning. A survey has shown positive feedback from students as well as identifying areas for improvement. They showed a video of students talking about why they like Auburn Academy. Ryan Schmit from TDA Architects and Roger Riachi, our Owner's Representative, gave an update on the CTE addition, the Riverview addition, and preliminary Buckeye addition plans. Mr. Prcela talked about financing options for the building additions. He gave an overview of borrowing options and the limitations of each.

11. Old Business - None

12. <u>New Business</u> – Mrs. Krenisky asked Mr. McIntyre to review Policy 0169.2 in light of reports of two board members working together outside of meetings. The date and time of January 8, 2025, at 7:30 am was set for the Tax Budget Hearing and the Organizational Meeting. Mrs. Krenisky brought up a document from the Auditor's Office and what action should be taken. It was decided that Mr. McIntyre would provide additional training at a work session and they would let the state do their own audit.

13. Board of Education Committee and Liaison Reports

A. Lori Krenisky – Superintendent's Business Advisory Liaison – The Business Advisory Council is currently working in small groups to further develop the Portrait of a Riverside Beaver.

- B. Denise Brewster Curriculum and Programming Committee; Facilities Liaison No Curriculum and Programming Committee or facilities update.
- C. Scott Fishel Buildings & Grounds/Operations Committee; Alumni Association Liaison The Buildings and Grounds Committee met in December. Mr. Arlesic commended the maintenance department on the snow removal. Cincinnati Floors has been contacted about the LaMuth gym floor buckling. Inspections and a hazardous material report will be completed over winter break. The motherboards are being replaced on the intrusion alarms. LaMuth teachers have reported 29 doors that are unable to lock from the inside. They ranked the Construction Manager at Risk firms for the Riverview project. No Alumni update.
- D. Belinda Grassi Policy Committee; Legislative Liaison The adoption of a large number of new policies is on the agenda. There is also a new policy on the agenda for a first reading. No Legislative update.
- **14.** <u>Superintendent's Report</u> Dr. Rateno said all schools participated in Community Kindness Day. Over 170 campus students helped to coordinate Halls of Holly and hundreds of community members attended. The Riverside Campus received the PBIS Bronze Award for the 23-24 school year. The winter sports season is underway. Over 40 local vendors attended the NHS Craft Show. Save the date of March 15 from 8 11 am for the 75 year celebration of Riverside.

- A. Dennis Keeney Finance/Audit and Personnel Committee; Booster Organization Liaison The Finance/Audit and Personnel Committee met on December 12. Personnel turnover and postings were reviewed. Science of Reading reimbursements and military recruitment awards payments continue. They discussed legal fees, ESC service contract modifications, state subsidy credits, and moving forward with the ESCNEO Passport services. Five Year Forecast updates and PI funding options were reviewed. No Booster update.

A Leroy Township resident spoke again about Mr. Fishel wanting to run a three-person board and is trying to find a way to do that without getting into trouble. He is now flirting with the idea of encumbering the district's real estate in a manner that could lose control of the school. (Mr. Prcela) understands the implications in a way none of the board will and they should listen very carefully to what he said. Mr. Fishel wants to control everything and if the board goes along with him it will be a disaster. When he is voted off the board, it will be the people of the district and the students who will suffer, possibly for decades or generations. Be very careful spending money that the district does not have and without the approval of the voters who may never approve a levy again. What you are doing is not only for this board, but any board that succeeds you.
