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InView Testing Week of February 18th

InView is a nationally normed test taken by all second and fifth graders in our district. This test measures a student's ability to use information and apply it in new and different ways, evaluating how a student analyzes and employs higher-order thinking skills (including verbal reasoning, sequences, analogies and quantitative reasoning), and measuring a student's cognitive reasoning skills.

From the Clinic

The health and well being of our students and staff is of utmost importance. If your child has a fever, they may return to school once they are fever free for 24 hours without the use of fever reducing medication.

If your child is vomiting or has diarrhea, the child may return to school once symptoms are clear 24 hours **without** use of medication.
