3. OSBA Call to Action - Legislative Platform

- A. Discussion Mr. Hach said that no input has been received from administrators, teachers, the community or parents regarding the change to the OSBA platform. Mrs. Grassi thinks we need more time for input from other sources, and that our attorney should compose our board's thoughts instead of copying someone else. Mrs. Harden feels this should be tabled until next year to properly research the issues and get input from the involved parties. Mr. Fishel said he does not understand the resistance when some of this is already in our policies. Mrs. Krenisky believes that parents are getting enough information from teachers now. She asked if the board is willing to let this go to the Policy Committee to make changes to the resolution. Dr. Kalis asked if we should get more feedback from the stakeholders before we edit the resolution. He feels that this is impractical because it states that all materials being used must be shared. Spur of the moment teachable content will not be usable if it's not shared with the parents first. Mrs. Krenisky said most of the points in the resolution were taken from NEOLA. Mr. Hach said the policy that protects parents' right to know is weak at OSBA. This will strengthen that policy. Dr. Kalis asked each board member to edit the resolution with what they would like to see included then bring to the Policy Committee for revision. Mrs. Harden would like Mr. McIntyre to be present for the meeting. Mrs. Krenisky said to get feedback to the Policy Committee and they will make changes to the document then send it to Mr. McIntyre for review. Feedback should be given to Mrs. Harden by May 10.
