Welcome, Mr. Mayer

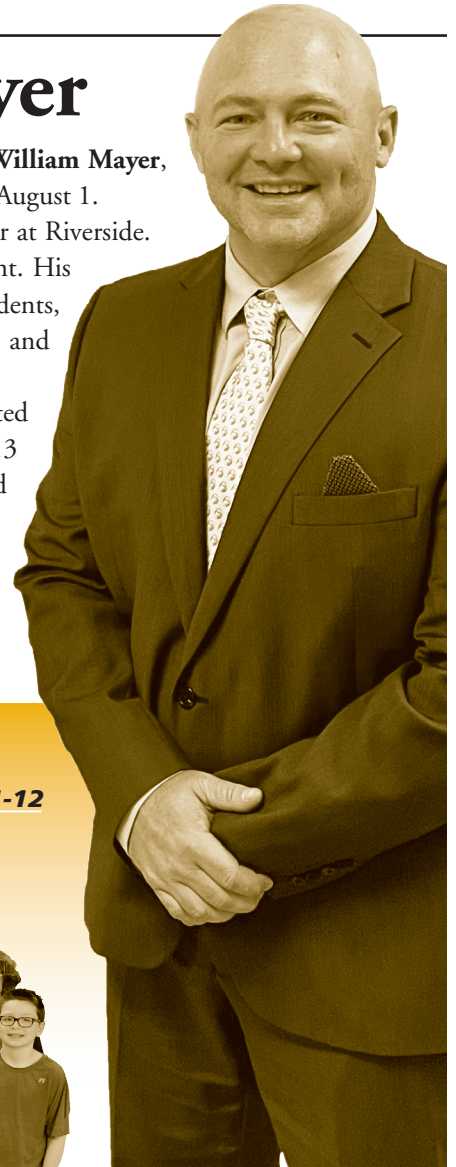
The Board of Education recently approved the hiring of **William Mayer**, who will become the principal at Riverside Campus effective August 1.

The bond levy for Phase II of the District's Facilities Plan was defeated by voters on May 3, 2022. While we are disappointed with the final result, we respect the outcome. We'd like to thank the many levy volunteers and community members who supported Issue 1.

As many are aware, this bond levy was Phase II of our overall, long-term District Facilities Plan, which was created by a committee of community members, parents, staff and board members back in 2014. Since the plan's creation, we had promised that we would allow the community to decide on whether or not the District would go forward with Phase II.

Moving forward, the Riverside administration team will continue to work with the Board of Education to determine the next steps to try and resolve issues of our growing population, combined with the poor and aging infrastructure that has a limited capacity. In the meantime, we will continue to do all that we can with the facilities that we have and will remain committed to providing the best education possible for all of our students.

Kyle McKee Dedication

On Saturday, June 4, there was a dedication for the renaming of a portion of state Route 86 in honor of Riverside High School graduate and **Staff Sgt. Kyle R. McKee** at the VFW (12827 Painesville-Warren Road) in Leroy Township. The dedication service was open to the public and community members were encouraged to attend to meet Kyle's family and share memories of Kyle with others.



McKee tragically passed away in a Black Hawk helicopter crash in Egypt on November 12, 2020. He was a 2003 Riverside High School graduate. This April, Ohio

Governor Mike DeWine signed House Bill 291 into law, which designates a portion of state Route 86 in Leroy Township as the "SSG Kyle R. McKee Memorial Highway."

During McKee's service, he received more than 20 military awards, including the Army Achievement Medal, the Meritorious Service Medal and the Global War on Terrorism Service Medal.

Spirit Store — Now Online

The Riverside High School Beaver Nation Spirit Store is now accepting online orders. You can visit the spirit store on the District website under the Community tab. Orders are pick-up only during the school year. (Orders placed during the summer months can be picked up in September.)

The store was launched in the fall of 2021 by students in the Principles of Business course, taught by Mr. Bill Ross. The course was designed by Mr. Ross, with facilitation by members of the administrative team, the District's Business Advisory Council, and a Willoughby South High School business teacher. The course is aligned with the federal business standards. The students have created a variety of designs and have developed products on demand using an apparel press purchased with grant money awarded

from the Martha Holden Jennings Foundation.

The store was open to staff and students during the school days and parents and community members during select school/athletic events in the evening. The Beaver Nation Store is located on the second floor of Riverside High School in room 205R.

School Meals Update

Federal meal waivers from the USDA for the National School Lunch and Breakfast Programs that were in place during the COVID-19 pandemic have expired.

Beginning with the 2022-2023 school year, students will no longer receive breakfast and lunch at no cost unless they qualify for free or reduced-price meals. Children must be eligible for free or reduced-price meals, either through direct certification or an approved free or reduced-price meal application. The application will be available to fill out after July 1. The electronic version, which is the most efficient way to apply, can be found in the Infinite Campus parent portal. If a paper copy is needed, contact the Nutrition Services office at (440) 358-8212. If a child previously was eligible, that status carries over for the first 30 days of the new school year.

The District accepts online payments through the Infinite Campus parent portal, or payment can be made by check or cash at the register. Please contact the Nutrition Services office with any questions or concerns.

Compass Award Recipient

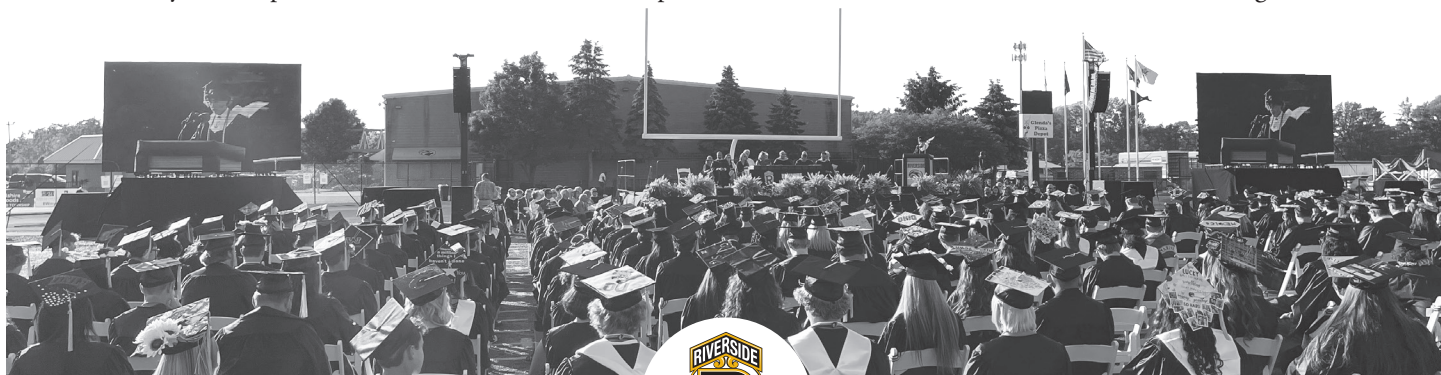
The District was recently recognized with the Compass Award.

Registration for 2022-23 School Year

If you are new to the Riverside Local School District or have children entering kindergarten, you must register your children online at www.riversidelocalschools.com. Parents and guardians no longer need to visit the Board Office to register their children. However, if you do not have access to a computer or the internet, you can make an appointment with Crystal DiFranco to register your child.

To complete the online registration, visit www.riversidelocalschools.com and click on the Registration Information link under the Parents tab. You will need: birth

certificate, proof of residency, custody papers (if applicable), driver's license or photo ID, immunization records, and current IEP and ETR (if applicable). Some of these items will need to be scanned and uploaded to the Online Registration. If you do not have the ability to upload documents, you can still complete the Online Registration, but the required documents must be submitted in person to Crystal DiFranco's office. The District cannot finalize or accept the registration without the required documents.
