Thank You, Dr. Kalis!

At the December 15, 2022 Board of Education Meeting, the Board accepted the retirement of Superintendent Dr. James P. Kalis, effective July 31, 2023.

Dr. Kalis has been with the Riverside Local School District for 26 years. He is currently the 24th longest tenured superintendent in the entire state of Ohio, having served as the head of the District since 2007.

In addition, he has also served as the Assistant Superintendent (2003-2007), Principal of Riverside Campus (2001-2003), Principal at LaMuth Middle School (1999-2001) and Assistant Principal of Riverside Campus (1997-1999).

"I have certainly enjoyed my 26 years at Riverside serving in multiple leadership roles," Dr. Kalis said. "I would like to thank all former and current members of the Board of Education for giving me the opportunity to serve the children of the school district and making compulsory public education my life's work."

Dr. Kalis has impacted the lives of thousands of staff members, students and community members throughout the past 26 years. We cannot thank him enough for his leadership, service and dedication to the



District and the community.

The Board of Education is currently working with the Ohio School Boards Association (OSBA) to conduct an extensive Superintendent search.

Dear Riverside Schools Community . . .

As you may already be aware, I have submitted notice to the Riverside Board of Education of my intent to retire effective August 1, 2023. The Board accepted my retirement letter through a resolution at its regularly scheduled monthly meeting on December 15, 2022. Naturally, this decision was a difficult one for me as I have served nearly 35 years as an educator, 26 of those serving in various leadership roles at Riverside, most recently 16 years as Superintendent. I submitted the notice nearly seven months in advance to provide the Board with enough time to thoroughly search for my replacement.

I certainly consider myself fortunate to have been surrounded by committed teachers and administrators, a hard-working staff, great students, active

parents, and a supportive community. Our collaborative efforts have helped to stabilize our fiscal resources, enhance our instructional programming, and make significant capital improvements to our facilities and safety protocols. As for the future, we have developed a comprehensive strategic plan that will help guide our District toward continuous improvement for the next several years. None of this could have been possible without the genuine effort and support of all district stakeholders.

In the coming months, I look forward to working with, and transitioning in, a new superintendent. I am certain that my replacement will be afforded the same type of support that I have been fortunate to have received during my

tenure with the District. Come August, I will leave Riverside with a lifetime of memories while deeply cherishing the meaningful personal and professional relationships that I have made. I have the utmost confidence that Riverside will continue to be a great place for students to live, work, and learn.

Finally, I would also like to thank all former and current members of the Riverside Local School District Board of Education for giving me the opportunity to serve the children of the school District and making compulsory public education my life's work.

Strategic Plan Update

The District has been working on a new Strategic Plan since the beginning of 2021. A Strategic Plan helps school districts set goals and focus on areas to improve upon. To assist the District, the Board of Education hired Educational Partnerships Institute (EPI) to help facilitate the Strategic Plan. This organization has been working with school districts all over the state of Ohio for more than 30 years.

As part of this process, EPI conducted surveys and hosted focus groups with students, staff, board members, parents and community members to help define our priorities for the next several years. Through these surveys and focus groups, stakeholders were given the opportunity to share their thoughts on the District and what their experience has been like with our schools.

Once EPI gathered all the information from these surveys and focus groups, we were able to determine four key focus areas for a new Strategic Plan: Safety, Climate, and Wellness; Advocacy, Partnerships, and Engagement; Fiscal Sensibility; Teaching and Learning. In the summer of 2022, the Board of Education approved the District's new Strategic Plan.

Since the Board's approval, we have been busy implementing new ideas and strategies to help achieve goals among the four key focus areas. Some of these include, but are not limited to:

- Implementing career exploration and pathway programming into our schools
- Increasing career readiness opportunities and technical courses
- Increasing staff professional development
- Using data to drive instruction
- Creating a new facilities plan
- Seeking grants and new revenue streams for District initiatives
- Increasing transparency among District finances
- Developing staff and student celebration and recognition programs
- Creating student-leadership groups at all our schools;
- Improving safety protocols in all our buildings
- Strengthening our relationships with the local business community and elected officials
- Highlighting and celebrating the success of our alumni



\$400,000 Safety Grant Awarded

The Riverside Local School District was awarded \$400,000 from the Ohio K-12 School Safety Grant Program. Buckeye Elementary, Melridge Elementary, LaMuth Middle School, and the Riverside Campus will each receive \$100,000 to be used towards safety improvements. Parkside and Riverview Elementary Schools were not eligible for the grant.

The District has earmarked these safety grant funds to install new secure entrances at each of its legacy buildings. Each new entrance will include a secure vestibule between two sets of locked doors to ensure visitors are properly vetted before entering our schools. These new entrances will be designed using current best practices for school safety. The District is currently under

contract with ThenDesign Architecture (TDA) of Willoughby, Ohio for design services related to this project.

Design is expected to be completed in the coming weeks with the goal of bidding the project out in the spring. Construction is anticipated to occur during the summer break with the goal of completing this project in time for the 2023-2024 school year.

Riverside High School is proud to announce its newest inductees into the Dr. Mary Allen Porter Chapter of the National Honor Society.

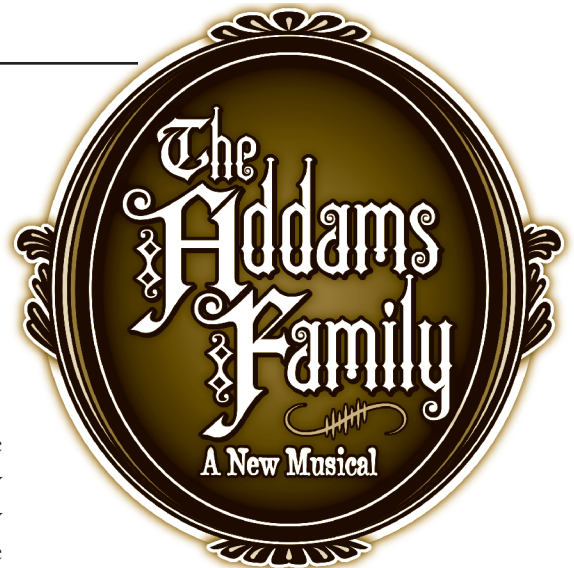
