Members of the Sophomore, Junior and Senior classes that met the G.P.A. requirement and completed the NHS packet were evaluated and screened by the Faculty Council consisting of five members of the faculty.

Leadership is based on the student's participation in community and school activities, and appointment or election to an office. To meet the service requirement, the student must have been active in three or more service projects in the school or community. Character is measured in terms of integrity, behavior, ethics, and cooperation with both students and faculty.

This year 40 students are being inducted into the Riverside Chapter of National Honor Society.

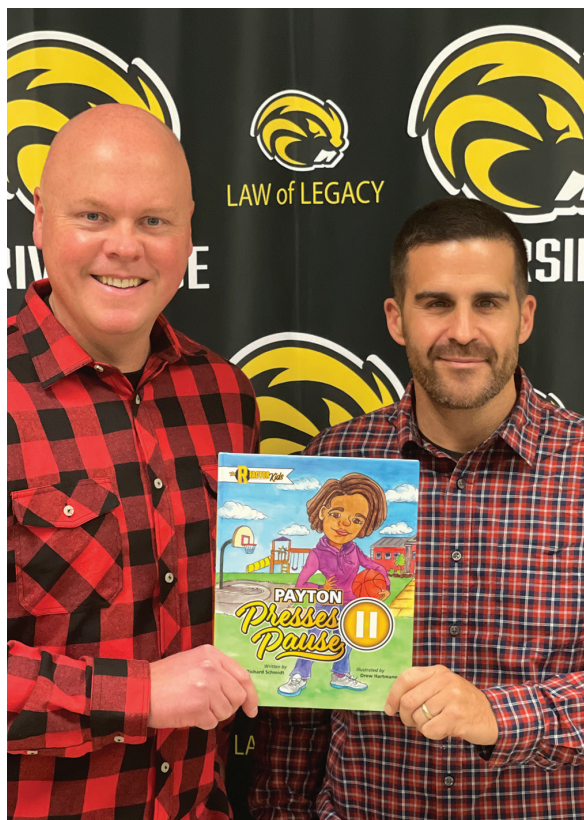
The official Induction Ceremony will be held January 10 at 6 p.m. in the D.W. Shaner Auditorium.
