## Thank You, Maintenance!

Our Maintenance Department has gone above and beyond this summer preparing our buildings and grounds for the start of the school year.

The department's staff moves every piece of furniture out of the classrooms to wash individually. Once the classrooms are empty, they top scrub and wash floors/clean carpet. Once the rooms are cleaned, the furniture is moved back into the classroom. There are a total of 240 classrooms District-wide, 1,350 desks, 4,121 tables, 6,637 chairs and 74 bathrooms. They also tended to the HVAC needs of all buildings, replacing 467 box filters, cleaning and servicing 160 univents and cleaning and inspecting 15 boiler systems. They completed all of this work in two months.

In addition to the inside of the buildings, our Maintenance staff maintains 82 acres of grass on a weekly basis, while also laying out, lining and maintaining multiple fields used for athletics or band.
