New... Melridge Security Vestibule **Fully Modified for SAFETY**

We are excited to report that construction has begun on our security vestibule project at Melridge Elementary. All four of our legacy buildings will have improved, secure vestibule entrances to increase the safety and security for our staff and students.

The vestibules at these buildings will include two layers of entrance doors with a transaction window in between. These updated entrances will allow for visitors to be properly vetted between the two sets of locked doors before entering the building.

The transaction window will allow for visitors to drop off deliveries without having to enter the building. The entrances will also feature a handicap button that will open doors, a new buzzer and intercom system, and new cameras.

Construction at Melridge Elementary is expected to be completed soon and the other three legacy buildings are tentatively expected to be completed in time for the start of the 2024-2025 school year.

New security vestibules for Buckeye, LaMuth and Riverside Campus are scheduled to be completed prior to the start of the 2024-2025 school year.
