Student of the Week

In a few weeks we will start having a different student be the Student of the Week! The student will bring home a special stuffed animal from our classroom and some books. There will be a journal for your child to write about their adventures!!

What We're Learning

Reading. Since this was just the first week of school we are

starting out VERY slow. The week we reviewed letter sounds, letters, and RHYMING. Rhyming is a very important skill for a beginner reader. We also learned about the beginning steps of our Daily 5: good book handling skills, where to read in our room, 3 ways to read a book (read the words, look at the pictures and talk about what is happening, retell a story you already know), and we began day one of read to self and worked on our stamina! It may not seem like much but learning the routines for the rest of the year are very important. I am also working on benchmarking each student so that I can start with leveled reading groups. Sight Words: For the first two weeks of school we are focusing on color words and number words. Then we will move right on to our Fry Sight Words.

Math: This week we did some graphing, number writing, and learning number words. The students worked very hard on a math (pre-assessment) that will help us show growth throughout the year! I am VERY proud of their hard work!!

Phonics/Writing: In phonics we are working or Unit 1 in Fundations which focuses letter sounds and correct letter formation. We have just begun journal writing.

Extra information:

- I think that warmer weather may be making a return! I don't mind if the students bring a water bottle to keep at their desk as long as it Closes securely. (I'm sure we will have a few spills, and that's Ok! ☺)
- Fridays are going to be Riverside Spirit Days at Buckeye. Each Friday students are asked to wear either black/gold or any Riverside/Buckeye clothes if they have them. Fridays we will be showing our Riverside Pride.
