What We're Learning

Reading: I have almost finished testing everyone on Fry Words lists 3&4. Then our focus will be on lists 5 and 6. (I will send those words home to practice next week. I can tell the students have really been practicing their words at home. We had our first student make it through all 15 lists this week!! That is amazing! We have been working hard in our reading groups. Some groups are working on accuracy strategies and other groups are focusing more on fluency and comprehension.

Grammar: Next week we will be taking a test on nouns. Our next focus will be on verbs. I REALLY loved our interactive writing with the Thankful Bags! Thank you so much for helping with this! The students learned so much about reading, writing, and nouns through this. I think we may do a similar activity after break that will help us focus on verbs!

Phonics/Word Study: We are continuing our study of glued sounds. This week we will focus on the –nk glued sounds (ank, ink, onk, unk words). If your child is having trouble with these try posting the 4 endings on file cards/something. When working with the words at home they can refer to the cards if they are struggling with the ending sounds.

Math- We took a test this week on what we have been learning in Eureka about adding numbers to 20. The rest of this unit will be heavily focusing on subtraction within 20. The new math really focuses on the students showing how to solve problems by drawing pictures and writing the number sentence with it.

S.S- We will be talking a lot about different winter holidays in the next two weeks. We really just focus on the different
