What We're Learning

Reading. We have just begun our fourth daily in Daily 5-Read with Someone. We talk about how we need to sit Elbow, Elbow, Knee, Knee book in the middle so we both can see (we call this EEK just in case you hear your child talking about it. We added a new accuracy strategy this week called Stretchy Snake (we stretch the sounds out in a word that we don't know by using our motions, tapping it, "arming it", or just sounding it out! I encourage you to ask your child if they can show you what it means to "tap out a word"! If they get stuck on a word at home while reading ask them to use one of their reading strategies: Eagle Eye, Lips the Fish, and Stretchy the Snake! I will be sending home a reading log for your child (or you) to write down what they are reading at home. There are a few Reading Clubs that I am participating in. As long as your child is reading at least 60 min. a week they will earn a pizza coupon at the end of the month.

Phonics/Word Study: Next week in Word Study we will have a review over the words from the last two units. The format for this test will be a little different. I will be reading a sentence to the children. They will need to find the misspelled spelling word, circle it, and then write it correctly on the line. Don't worry, we will be practicing this a lot at school. I will also be sending home some other things next week that will help you practice at home.

Fundations- Next week we will begin Unit 3 in our Fundations/Phonics.

Our focus will be on Digraphs (2 letters that make 1 sound)

You will get more information about this next week!!

Math: Next week we will be working with Addition Fluency within 10. We will be talking about Doubles and Doubles +1 facts. The students are doing a great job with number bonds and writing 4 addition equations with a number bond! I am so proud of them!
